3. a. What commandments had these people broken? (See Exodus 20:1-6,14)
  - b. Exodus 20:5 states that God is a jealous God. Summarize God's contempt statement against "other gods" from these Scriptures:

Habakkuk 2:18,19
4. a. What did the Lord instruct Moses to do and why?
  - b. What did Moses instruct the judges of Israel to do?
  - c. Why do people today argue about the death penalty?

5. a. God had sent a plague on Israel because of their sins with the Moabites. In the midst of this, in sight of Moses and the whole congregation, who was brought in? (Read also Psalm 106:28-31)
  - b. Why do you think this incident was so offensive to Phinehas?
6. a. What action did Phinehas take?
  - b. As a result of his quick action, the \_\_\_\_\_ was stopped. How many died?
  - c. What promise did God give Phinehas for his quick action?

9. a. Israel was preparing to enter Canaan. Moses and Eleazar were to do what?  
  
b. What was the total census?  
  
c. Compare this census to the one taken the second year after leaving Egypt (Numbers 1:46). What was the decrease?  
  
d. These people had been traveling approximately 40 years. With such a small decrease in the census, what does this indicate to you about God's concern for Israel?
10. a. For what two purposes did the Lord order the census (vs.2 and 52-56)?  
  
b. How would division of the land be decided?
11. What was the name of Moses, Aaron and Miriam's grandfather?
12. a. List the children born to Aaron.  
  
b. What happened to two of them?
13. a. What was the total number of Levites?  
  
b. According to God's instructions, the Levites were not given a land inheritance. In review, what was their inheritance (Numbers 18:20,21)?
14. What previous judgment of the Lord is restated in verse 65?
