 - g. Paul arrived back in Ephesus. From Acts 19:1, where had Apollos gone to preach?
4. In the opening statement of his letter to the church at Corinth, how did Paul establish his authority?
5. In verse 2 Paul wrote to "all those everywhere . . ." What is the value to us today of studying about an early church in Corinth?
