

Isaiah 30:21 Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it."

We see the themes of trust and reliance. How important are they as we walk in the world. God sees your path, you don't. We will hear Him as we place our trust in Him through His holy word and His words of wisdom. I must rely his divine counsel rather than on my flimsy attempts.
