5. Isaiah 52:15 speaks of a spiritual awakening that will astound the nations. Why do you think the gospel message of salvation through the blood of Christ brings such a reaction?
  
6. How did Paul fulfill the prophecy of vs. 15 in Romans 15:18-21?

**DAY 3 – READ Isaiah 53:1-3**

7. What had Jesus done in John 12:37-38 that fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah 53:1?
  
8. What do you think are some reasons people give for unbelief?

**DAY 3 (Continued) – READ Isaiah 53:1-3**

- 9.a. How was the Servant described as to physical appearance?
- b. If physical appearance did not draw crowds to see Jesus, what do you think drew them?
- c. In your opinion, what attributes should a Christian possess to draw people to Christ?
- 10.a. How is the Servant described in vs. 3?
- b. (IN-DEPTH) Share an instance from the ministry of Christ that . . .  
    . . . brought Him rejection from men.  
    . . . brought Him sorrow.

**DAY 4 – READ Isaiah 53:4-9**

11. To sinful mankind the Servant was considered as what in vs. 4?
12. From vs. 5-6:
- a. What happened to the Servant because of our transgressions (sins)?
- b. How are we healed (from sin)?
- c. What happened to our sin or “iniquities”?
13. Read 1 Peter 2:21-25. Christ left us an example.
- a. How did He act when reviled?
- b. Why did He die on the cross?
14. What does Isaiah 53:7-9 say about . . .
- a. the Servant’s silence?

Read Matthew 27:11-14. Jesus was silent before whom?

**DAY 4 (Continued) – READ Isaiah 53:4-9**

14.b. the Servant's death?

Write Matthew 27:38.

Read Matthew 27:57-60. Who was the rich man and how was he involved in Jesus' death?

15.a. The Servant was silent. What are we to do from Psalm 105:1-2?

b. Write a sentence prayer and do that.
