b. What did the disciples do while waiting?

 - a. What might he remember from Luke 5:1-11?

b. . . . from John 13:38?
 - c. What are some of the things you do or think about when you feel the need to examine yourself or "fall back and regroup?"
 - d. Peter had seen Christ's victory but he needed to make it his victory. What encouragement is found in Isaiah 41:10?

DAY 2 – READ John 21:4-14

4. What did Jesus teach the disciples about Himself in helping them get the large catch of fish?
5. How did Peter react to John's announcement, "It is the Lord!"?
6. What did they find on shore?
7. What effort did Jesus demand?

14. a. What principles did Jesus teach Peter in today's reading about obedience and discipleship?

 - c. Remember 1 Peter 3:15. In witnessing you are told, "I know I have a lot of faults, but there are a lot more people worse than I am!" Your response?
