b. Why did the owner decide to delay action?  
c. What would be done at the harvest?
4. In verses 36-43, how did Jesus explain the following:
  - a. He who sows good seed
  - b. the field
  - c. the good seed
  - d. the weeds
  - e. the enemy
  - f. the harvest
  - g. the reapers
5. a. At the end of the age, what will the angels do?  
b. What will happen to the righteous?
6. Why do you think Jesus added the statement, "He who has ears, let him hear?"
7. Applying this parable to the church today:
  - a. In what way do you think the church is sleeping while the enemy is at work?
  - b. How should we respond to tares if we think we recognize them?
  - c. Why do you think Hell is/is not an appropriate sermon topic?

**(Mark 4:26-34; Luke 13:18-21)**

  - b. (IN-DEPTH) What do you think the "birds of the air" represent?
9. What does leaven/yeast do to dough?
10. In the parables of the hidden treasure and a valuable pearl, what does sacrifice have to do with the kingdom of heaven?
11. a. The kingdom of God is compared to what in Matthew 13:47-50?
  - b. What theme is common to this parable and the parable of the tares?
12. Teachers of the Law (Old Testament instruction) who have been instructed about the kingdom of heaven (New Testament instruction) have what to offer?
13. In Mark 4:26, seed was scattered. Who is the one that spread the seed that started your development? Have you thanked and encouraged that person? If not, do so today!

24. The account in Matthew 8:28-34 differs in one aspect. What is it?
25. Share a spiritual "pearl" that you've hidden in the field of your heart that is a treasure to you.
