## GLOSSARY

1. **Abomination of Desolation:** Anti-Christ
2. **Anti-Christ:** One who passes himself off as Messiah or Christ given over completely to Satan with his power – the devil in the flesh – last world ruler.
3. **Apocalyptic:** Prophecies concerning destruction of evil.
4. **Apostasy:** A falling away from truth (2 Thessalonians 2:3) or departure from that which was given at first.
5. **Armageddon:** Plain of Jezreel ("God sows"). Valley of Jehosaphat – a literal place of battle between God's armies and forces hostile to God.
6. **Day of the Lord:** O.T. concept referring to God's judgment. Also called "that day" or the last days or, as in Amos, the idea of vindication.
7. **Eschatology:** The study of last things/times. (Greek word "es-ka-ton" - end times)
8. **Great Tribulation:** A 7-year span of time during which the whole world is in chaotic distress when the Anti-Christ or Man of Sin emerges and becomes enthroned and then reveals himself. Day of Jacob's "trouble" / Daniel's 70th week.
9. **Great White Throne Judgment:** The very end of time. A throne of sentencing those already declared guilty.
10. **HADES:** The abode of the dead – both paradise and torment.
11. **Hope:** Expectation – not simply a wish or desire.
12. **7 Judgments:** Of sin at Calvary; of sin of believer in his daily life (1 Corinthians 11:31,32); "bema" judgment seat of Christ after rapture for reward; of Gentile nations at Second Coming; Jewish nation preceding the millennium; of fallen angels (Revelation 20:14,15); Great White Throne (Revelation 20:11,15).
13. **Kingdom:** All under the authority of Christ as King.
14. **Last Days:** All time since the resurrection.
15. **Millennium:** Period of 1000 years when Christ will rule with an iron rod and there will be peace – Satan bound.
16. **Rapture:** A catching up out of . . . word not found in Bible but used as an English word for event of church caught up in the air (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18). Resurrection of the Redeemed.

"But when the fullness of time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law."

### **Born of a virgin**

"She was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit. And Joseph . . . kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he called His name Jesus." Matthew 1:18, 24-25

### **Son of God**

". . . And behold, a voice (spoke) out of the heavens saying, 'This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased.'" Matthew 3:17

### **Seed of Abraham**

"The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham." Matthew 1:1

### **Son of Isaac**

"(Jesus) . . . the son of Isaac . . ." Luke 3:23,24

### **Son of Jacob**

"(Jesus) . . . the son of Jacob . . ." Luke 3:23,24

### **Tribe of Judah**

"(Jesus) . . . the son of Judah . . ." Luke 3:33

### **Family of Jesse**

"(Jesus) . . . the son of Jesse . . ." Luke 3:23,32

### **House of David**

"(Jesus) . . . the son of David . . ." Luke 3:23,31

### **Born at Bethlehem**

"After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem." Matthew 2:1

### **Jewish children suffer**

"When Herod realized that he had been outwitted by the Magi, he was furious, and he gave orders to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity who were two years old and under. In accordance with the time he had learned from the Magi." Matthew 2:16

### **He shall be a prophet**

"And the multitudes were saying, this is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth in Galilee." Matthew 21:11

### **He shall be a priest**

"So Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, 'Thou art My son, today I have begotten Thee'; just as He says also in another passage, 'Thou art a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.'" Hebrews 5:5-6

**He shall be a judge**

"Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father." John 5:22-23

**He shall be king**

"And they put above His head the charge against Him which read, 'This is Jesus the King of the Jews.'" Matthew 27:37

**Anointing of God's Spirit**

"And after being baptized, Jesus went up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he (John) saw the spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming upon Him . . ." Matthew 3:16,17

**Zeal for God**

"And He made a scourge of cords, and drove them all out of the temple saying 'Take these things away; stop making My Father's house a house of merchandise.'" John 2:15-17

**Ministry in Galilee**

"When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, he returned to Galilee. Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali - to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah..." Matthew 4:12-16

**Ministry of Miracles**

"And Jesus was going about all the cities and the villages, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness." Matthew 9:35

**Teacher of parables**

"All these things Jesus spoke to the multitudes in parables, and He was not talking to them without a parable . . ." Matthew 13:34

**Would enter Jerusalem on a donkey**

"The disciples went and did as Jesus had instructed them. They brought the donkey and the colt, placed their cloaks on them, and Jesus sat on them. A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, 'Hosanna to the son of David!' 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!'" Matthew 21:6-9

**Rejection by the Jews**

"He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him." John 1:11

**Silent when accused**

"Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, 'Are you not going to answer? What is the testimony that these men are bringing against you?' But Jesus remained silent." Matthew 26:62

**Numbered with transgressors**

"Two robbers were crucified with him, one on His right and one on His left." Matthew 27:38

**Hands and feet pierced**

"And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him . . ." Luke 23:33

**Given gall and vinegar**

"A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips." John 19:29

**His side pierced**

"Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water." John 19:34

**Clothing divided**

"And they crucified him, dividing up His clothes, they cast lots to see what each would get." Mark 15:24

**No bones broken**

"But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs." John 19:33

**Darkness over the land**

"Now from the sixth hour darkness fell upon all the land until the ninth hour." Matthew 27:45

**Buried with the rich**

"As evening approached there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away." Matthew 27:57-60

**His resurrection**

"Then he said to Thomas. Put your finger here, see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." John 20:27
