

## **ISAIAH MEMORY VERSES NIV**

1. Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, let us reason together," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool."
2. Isaiah 3:10 Tell the righteous it will be well with them, for they will enjoy the fruit of their deeds.
3. Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"
4. Isaiah 7:9b If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all.
5. Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
6. Isaiah 12:2 Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation.
7. Isaiah 14:12 How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations!
8. Isaiah 14:24 The Lord Almighty has sworn, "Surely, as I have planned, so it will be, and as I have purposed, so it will stand."
9. Isaiah 21:6 This is what the Lord said to me: "Go, post a lookout and have him report what he sees."
10. Isaiah 24:5 The earth is defiled by its people; they have disobeyed the laws, violated the statutes and broken the everlasting covenant.
11. Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.
12. Isaiah 29:18 In that day the deaf shall hear the words of the scroll, and out of gloom and darkness the eyes of the blind will see.
13. Isaiah 30:21 Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ear will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it."
14. Isaiah 35:10 And the ransomed of the Lord will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.
15. Isaiah 37:14 Hezekiah received the letter from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the Lord and spread it out before the Lord.
16. Isaiah 38:17 Surely it was for my benefit I suffered such anguish. In your love you kept me from the pit of destruction; you have put all my sins behind your back.
17. Isaiah 40:31 But those who wait on the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint.
18. Isaiah 43:25 I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remember your sins no more.

19. Isaiah 45:22 Turn to me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other.
20. Isaiah 46:4 Even to your old age and gray hairs I am he, I am he who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you.
21. Isaiah 50:4a The Sovereign Lord has given me an instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary.
22. Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who brings good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"
23. Isaiah 53:6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.
24. Isaiah 55:8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord.
25. Isaiah 57:15b "I live in a high and holy place, but also with him who is contrite and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly and to revive the heart of the contrite.
26. Isaiah 59:1 Surely the arm of the Lord is not too short to save, not his ear to dull to hear.
27. Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you.
28. Isaiah 61:10a I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness.
29. Isaiah 64:8 Yet, O Lord, you are our Father. We are the clay, you the potter; we all are the work of your hands.
30. Isaiah 65:24 Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear.
